

DUNFIELD HOUSE RESIDENIAL TRIP MONDAY 4TH OCTOBER - FRIDAY 8TH OCTOBER 2021

Dear Parent/Carer of Year 5 Children,

As you will be aware, due to the current Pandemic we had to postpone last year's residential trip for our current Year 5 children. We feel that the children have missed out a lot during this difficult time; we have therefore managed to book a residential trip to Dunfield House for October when your child will be in Year 6. This is a very important year for them and gives them great team building opportunities.

Dunfield House is situated in Kington, Herefordshire in a beautiful rural part of the country. The house is set in substantial grounds where the children will have the opportunity to get back to nature. They will learn to love dirt, paddle in the stream and step into the nature that is on their doorstep. The children will be supervised at all times by members of our staff. The activities will be based around the theme of 'Friends' and will be organised by St. Anthony's staff. These activities will include orienteering, exploring our world, shelter building, blindfolded night walk, campfire and crafts, to name but a few.

The cost of this trip will be £230.00 **+ £5.00 (cash) spending money**, which includes 5 days of activities and 4 nights' accommodation. This cost has been subsidised by the school. If you have financial difficulties please speak to Mrs Dhami in the school office to see if we can help you. Please note if we do not get sufficient commitment we may need to cancel the trip.

To secure your child's place please log in to your ParentPay account to pay a deposit of £80.00 by 16th July. We then ask for 2 monthly payments of £75.00, one by the end of August, one by the end of September.
