Literacy – writing

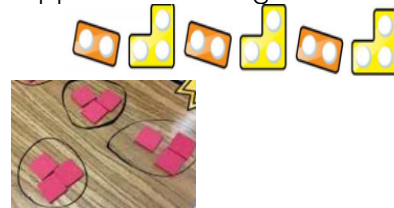
